Officer/Director Information

Election of Officers and Directors

- The officers will be elected by ballot at the annual Fort Worth meeting. The candidate must fill out the leadership application posted on the Texas Junior Angus Association website and submit by January 2.
- **To be an officer you must have served as a director for one (1) year.**
- The directors will be elected by acclamation. Directors must fill out the leadership application posted on the Texas Junior Angus Association website and submit by January 2. Officer candidates that are not elected can automatically serve as directors.
- The two (2) Voting Delegates from Texas will represent our state at the National Junior Angus Show in electing the National Junior Angus Board. These Delegates will be voted on at the Fort Worth noon meeting. The nominees should be officers or past officers.
- The President shall be required to attend meetings and the State and National shows. All officers shall be required to serve on committees for association activities. **If you are too busy to fulfill committee responsibilities, please do not run for an office. Please consider college plans, workload, etc. before applying.**

Procedure for Election of Officers

- At the beginning of elections, all officer candidates will be asked to give a short speech about themselves and why they are running for a Texas Junior Angus Association office. Candidates will not be allowed to give another speech prior to each office they are running for.
- Texas Junior Angus Board candidates are not allowed to hand out flyers or candy at or prior to the meeting. However, candidates are encouraged to visit with juniors in the barns.
- National Junior Angus Board candidates are allowed to distribute flyers **prior** to the meeting. However, candidates are not allowed to ask advisors to create or distribute flyers.
